

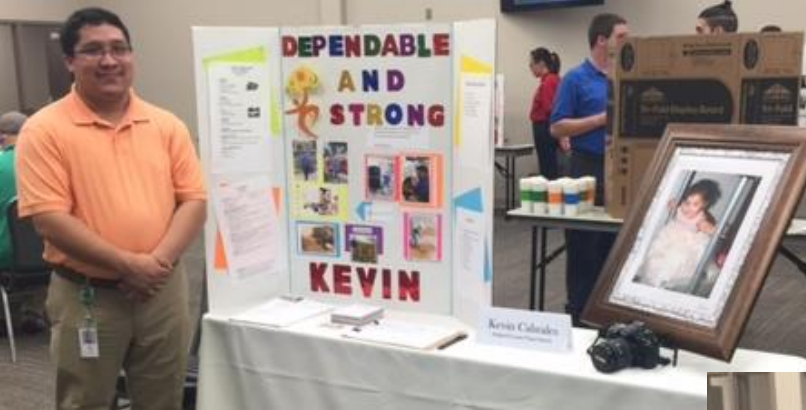

Project Search is a dedicated program focused on providing education and training to young adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. The program is an innovative workforce and career development model that benefits the individual, the workplace, and the community. The internship is one school year in length and consists of 3, ten week rotations through a host business. There are 4 Project Search sites in two school districts in Sedgwick County and one hybrid adult site. Wichita Public Schools has two of those sites, Sedgwick County government, and Via Christi Ascension Hospital. Derby Public Schools Project Search site is located at McConnell Air Force Base; Goodwill Industries has an Adult Hybrid site with Cintas. The primary goal for Project Search is to prepare each intern for competitive employment upon completion of the yearlong skill-building experience. The intern experience creates qualified individuals ready for many entry level jobs in many career fields.
